

## International Pledge for Nurses

I will respect at all times the dignity and religious beliefs of the patients under my care, holding in confidence all personal information entrusted to me, and refrain from any action which might endanger life or health.

I will endeavor to keep my professional knowledge and skill at the highest level and to give loyal support and cooperation to all members of the health team.

I will do my utmost to honor the international code of ethics applied to nursing and to uphold the integrity of the professional nurse.

## Physician Assistant Professional Oath

I pledge to perform the following duties with honesty and dedication:

I will hold as my primary responsibility, the health, safety, welfare and dignity of all human beings.

I will uphold the tenets of patient autonomy, beneficence, non-maleficence and justice.

I will recognize and promote the value of diversity.

I will treat equally all persons who seek my care.

I will hold in confidence the information shared in the course of practicing medicine.

I will assess my personal capabilities and limitations, striving always to improve my medical practice.

I will actively seek to expand my knowledge and skills, keeping abreast of advances in medicine.

I will work with other members of the health care team to provide compassionate and effective care of patients.

I will use my knowledge and experience to contribute to an improved community.

I will respect my professional relationship with the physician.

I will share and expand knowledge within the profession.

These duties are pledged with sincerity and upon my honor.

## Graduate Student Oath

I faithfully pledge to uphold my professional integrity by maintaining the highest standard of ethics and quality in my pursuit of academic and professional excellence.

I will uphold an unwavering commitment to report and interpret my research or professional findings with steadfast honesty and clarity.

I pledge to share openly and generously, my discoveries, obstacles and triumphs. I will work to improve our world through communication with peers and teaching students of all ages.

I will strive to be continually conscious of the responsibility that accompanies the endowment of my degree.

It is with tremendous pride and enthusiasm that I seal my commitment to advance humanity through extraordinary biomedical research, teaching or provision of service.

## Explanation of Physician's Oath

The Declaration of Geneva was promulgated by the World Medical Association in 1948. It has its roots in the great moral traditions that go back to ancient Greek Hippocratic medicine. It also seriously reflects the times in which it was written. That was immediately after World War II when the crimes of men against humanity were being revealed through such things at the Nuremberg Trial.

### Physician's Oath

(Modified Declaration of Geneva)

Now, being admitted to the profession of medicine, I solemnly pledge to consecrate my life to the service of humanity. I will practice medicine with conscience and dignity; the health and life of my patient will be my first consideration. I will maintain the utmost respect for human life, never using my knowledge contrary to the laws of humanity.

I will hold in confidence all that my patient confides in me.

I will not permit race, religion, nationality, party, politics or social standing to intervene between my duty and my patient. I will follow that method of treatment which I consider to be of greatest benefit, and never hesitate to confer with my colleagues in my patient's behalf. I will learn to distinguish when to treat aggressively and when to restrain my hand in the face of greater power.

I will maintain the honor and noble traditions of the medical profession. I will recognize hard-won scientific gains, and share my knowledge with those who follow. I will treat with respect all others in my profession. These promises I make freely and upon my honor.

## HONORARY DOCTORATE OF SCIENCE

Eric Matteson, MD, is awarded the honorary Doctor of Science degree for achievement in science and his service to our nation, as a physician, educator and researcher, and as a humanitarian.

Dr. Matteson, a University of Nebraska-Lincoln alumnus, is emeritus John F. Finn Professor of Medicine at the Mayo Clinic and was chair of its rheumatology division for 10 years. Mayo Clinic's rheumatology division returned to national and international prominence under his leadership, tripling in size and academic productivity during this time. Dr. Matteson's own scholarship has produced more than 500 journal articles and 60 book chapters. He's delivered lectures and presentations at meetings, conferences and symposia around the world.

He's also advanced the field through his study of medical history. Dr. Matteson, fluent in German, has made a worldwide impact through his examination of original medical manuscripts, some of which were the result of medical experimentation upon prisoners in concentration camps during World War II.

"This speaks volumes of his leadership, persistence and his humanity," said James O'Dell, MD, who was among those who nominated Dr. Matteson for this honor. "He has made giant contributions to the rheumatological world but also has a profound dedication to righting past wrongs and contributing to the overall good."

Dr. Matteson is a national figure in the rheumatology field, having held several leadership positions within the American College of Rheumatology and the American College of Physicians. He is former president of the Rheumatology Research Foundation, the nation's largest private funder of rheumatology research.

He is known for giving hours upon hours of his time as a volunteer at state and national parks, as well as through Habitat for Humanity and his hometown public library. He also volunteers his time and expertise as a physician and rheumatologist at free public health clinics, including through the Salvation Army.

He served as a major in the medical corps in the United States Army Reserve.

Among numerous awards and honors for teaching, clinical care and scholarship, Dr. Matteson was the recipient of the Hero Award from the Arthritis Foundation.

He was Phi Beta Kappa at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, where he studied political science and German. Dr. Matteson earned his medical degree at Friedrich-Alexander University, Erlangen-Nuremberg, Germany. He also studied at its nursing school. He was an intern and resident in the Michigan State University system (SMAHEC) and a fellow at the University of Michigan and the Mayo Clinic. Dr. Matteson later earned a Master of Public Health degree at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill.

The University of Nebraska is proud to award the honorary Doctor of Science degree to Eric Matteson, MD.

## ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps and gowns worn during formal academic occasions in American colleges today are the direct descendants of the everyday costumes worn in the universities of Medieval England. Each school had its own special attire so that an Oxford student could be distinguished from a Cambridge student, or a divinity student from a layman. Several costumes from European institutions are worn in today's ceremony by Medical Center faculty.

Because of the tremendous growth of American colleges and the confusion which would result if each were to adopt a distinctive costume, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume was organized. The Bureau has established a uniform code which over 700 institutions have adopted. Harvard, practically alone, still clings to its own traditional costumes.

The distinctions of the Code are simple, there being three types of gowns and three types of hoods for bachelors, masters, and doctors, respectively. The bachelor's gown has a long pointed sleeve, whereas the master's gown has a long closed sleeve, square at the end with an arc of a circle above the bottom. The sleeve extends well below the knee, the arm coming through a slit near the elbow. The doctor's gown is characterized by a voluminous bell-shaped sleeve on which appear three velvet bars and by velvet facings or panels of the same color down the front. The navy blue gown trimmed with scarlet velvet, worn by some members of the faculty, indicates fellowship in the American College of Surgeons.

The hood is the most important and distinctive feature of the Code. The hoods for all degrees are lined with silk in the official academic color or colors of the institution conferring the degree and have an edging or trim of velvet, the color of which indicates the course or faculty to which the degree pertains. The lining is exposed when the hood is worn. The bachelor's hood is rather short with a narrow velvet edging. It is not worn by candidates for the baccalaureate but only by those upon whom this degree has been previously conferred. The master's hood is considerably longer, has a wider velvet edging, and exposes more of the lining. The doctor's hood is easily recognized since, of the three types of hoods, it has the widest velvet edging, greatest length, and fullest exposure of the lining, and has wide panels at the side.

The black mortarboard cap with tassel is worn with each type of gown. Those holding a doctor's degree are privileged to wear a gold tassel. Masters and bachelors wear black gowns and tassels that are either black or of the color appropriate to the degree in which they are being graduated. Marshals wear cardinal tassels. The members of the Board of Regents wear doctor's gowns.

Candidates receiving degrees with **distinction**, **high distinction** and **highest distinction** wear medallions with red ribbons, white ribbons and red and white ribbons respectively. Candidates receiving medallions have demonstrated, during the course of their study, superior academic aptitude.

Candidates receiving degrees with **Academic Excellence** are advanced placement students in the Colleges of Nursing and Dentistry who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement.

The colors, which may be observed at this commencement and which symbolize various courses or faculties, are as follows:
