I will embrace and advocate change in the profession of pharmacy that improves patient care.

I take these vows voluntarily with the full realization of the responsibility with which I am entrusted by the public.

I will lend my influence and support to dental education, to organized dentistry and to all aspects of the profession.

These promises I make freely and without hesitation.



Explanation of Physician's Oath

The Declaration of Geneva was promulgated by the World Medical Association (WMA) in 1948. It has roots in the great moral traditions that go back to ancient Greek Hippocratic medicine. It also seriously reflects the times in which it was written. That was immediately after World War II when the crimes of men against humanity were being revealed through such things at the Nuremberg Trial. The current version was amended by the 68th WMA General Assembly in 2017.

The Physician's Pledge

(World Medical Association Declaration of Geneva)

AS A MEMBER OF THE MEDICAL PROFESSION:

I SOLEMNLY PLEDGE to dedicate my life to the service of humanity;

THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF MY PATIENT will be my first consideration;

I WILL RESPECT the autonomy and dignity of my patient;

I WILL MAINTAIN the utmost respect for human life;

I WILL NOT PERMIT considerations of age, disease or diability, creed, ethnic origin, gender, nationality, political affiliation, race, sexual orientation, social standing or any other factor to intervene between my duty and my patient;

I WILL RESPECT the secrets that are confided in me, even after the patient has died;

I WILL PRACTICE my profession with conscience and dignity and in accordance with good medical practice;

I WILL FOSTER the honor and noble traditions of the medical profession;

I WILL GIVE to my teachers, colleagues and students the respect and gratitude that is their due;

I WILL SHARE my medical knowledge for the benefit of the patient and the advancement of healthcare;

I WILL ATTEND TO my own health, well-being, and abilities in order to provide care of the highest standard;

I WILL NOT USE my medical knowledge to violate human rights and civil liberties, even under threat;

I MAKE THESE PROMISES solemnly, freely and upon my honor.

HONORARY DOCTORATE OF SCIENCE

The University of Nebraska awards Alexander (Sasha) Kabanov, PhD, an honorary Doctor of Science degree for achievement in science and his service to our nation and to the University of Nebraska Medical Center. Throughout his career he has personified intellectual leadership, dedication to the community, commitment to education and service to both the academic community and society at large.

Dr. Kabanov currently serves as Mescal S. Ferguson Distinguished Professor and the Director of the Center for Nanotechnology in Drug Delivery at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. But he continues to be associated, nationally and internationally, with Nebraska and UNMC, and we with him.



While serving as Parke-Davis Endowed Chair in Pharmaceutics at UNMC, he helped establish the first academic center of nanomedicine in the United States, the Nebraska Center for Nanomedicine. As one of his nominators for this award, Aaron Mohs, PhD, put it, Dr. Kabanov's influence upon UNMC and beyond is profound.

David Oupicky, PhD, the current Parke-Davis Chair, said: "As someone who has followed in his footsteps, I can attest to the profound impact he has had on our field, our institution, and the countless scientists he has inspired along the way. The fact that his legacy continues to open doors and create opportunities for Nebraska's scientific community more than a decade after his departure is perhaps the strongest testament to the lasting value of his contributions."

His scientific career has led to clinical trials, nearly \$122 million in total research funding, more than 350 peer reviewed publications, 80 trainees (including an NCI Cancer Nanotechnology Training Program), 38 issued patents, numerous companies and nearly 400 invited seminars at conferences and external institutions.

Dr. Kabanov is one of the pioneers in drug delivery and nanomedicine, having revolutionized the field through his groundbreaking work on polyelectrolyte complexes and polymeric micelles for drug delivery. His innovative research has led directly to an important milestone: the development of the first-in-class polymer micelle drug to reach human clinical trials. This achievement represented a pivotal moment in pharmaceutical sciences by bridging basic research and practical therapeutic applications. His work continues to advance our understanding of how therapeutic agents can be delivered to their targets in the body and has opened new possibilities for treating range of diseases.

He earned master's, PhD and Doctor of Chemical Sciences degrees from Lomonosov Moscow State University, USSR. A former UNMC Scientist Laureate, he has earned honors, awards and memberships too numerous to mention.

The University is proud to present this honorary Doctor of Science degree to Sasha Kabanov, PhD.



J. G. (JACK) ELLIOTT AWARD

Byron Barksdale, MD, is honored with the J.G. Elliott Award for his decades of service to his fellow Nebraskans, notably in the areas of health care, outreach to the underserved and public health. His vision and dedication to community helped bring critical health services to parts of Nebraska that were previously underserved.

After arriving in North Platte in 1981, Dr. Barksdale worked with several key community stakeholders to bring the first anesthesiologist to town in 1983. He and the group continued, establishing a cancer center, now Callahan Cancer Center, in 1985. Then a certified stroke center in 2009. And finally, after 28 years of lobbying and organization, a hyperbaric chamber, for the treatment of carbon monoxide poisoning and wound care. These crucial health services now stand as a beacon for Nebraskans who live in the western region of the state. They also serve residents of rural Colorado and Kansas.



Dr. Barksdale is the sole owner of Pathology Services, P.C., which was founded by former UNMC faculty member George Haslam, MD, in 1967. Pathology Services, based in North Platte, supports UNMC's pathology department and serves 19 critical access hospitals in Nebraska, Colorado and Kansas.

Dr. Barksdale serves as a consulting pathologist throughout the state. He's served as chief of the medical staff at Great Plains Health in North Platte and was elected twice by its medical staff to serve on the Great Plains Health hospital board of directors.

He is a Fellow of the American College of Preventive Medicine, a member of the American Medical Association and a Lab Inspector and Fellow of the College of American Pathologists.

Dr. Barksdale is an advocate for direct access testing for patients and melanoma awareness, promoting free skin examinations. He also volunteered for the Cuba AIDS Project, which led to his helping establish a Nebraska-Cuba international trade mission.

Dr. Barksdale holds a bachelor's degree in pharmacology from the University of Kentucky and earned his MD degree from the University of Kentucky College of Medicine. He has licenses to practice medicine in Nebraska, Kansas, Colorado, Texas, Florida and Hawaii.

The J.G. Elliott Award is given annually to an individual who has made significant contributions to medicine and health programs for the state of Nebraska.

It is awarded in memory of Jack Elliott, who served on the University of Nebraska Board of Regents for 20 years until his death in 1974. The University is proud to present this award to Byron Barksdale, MD.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps and gowns worn during formal academic occasions in American colleges today are the direct descendants of the everyday costumes worn in the universities of Medieval England. Each school had its own special attire so that an Oxford student could be distinguished from a Cambridge student, or a divinity student from a layman. Several costumes from European institutions are worn in today's ceremony by Medical Center faculty.

Because of the tremendous growth of American colleges and the confusion which would result if each were to adopt a distinctive costume, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume was organized. The Bureau has established a uniform code which over 700 institutions have adopted. Harvard, practically alone, still clings to its own traditional costumes.

The distinctions of the Code are simple, there being three types of gowns and three types of hoods for bachelors, masters, and doctors, respectively. The bachelor's gown has a long pointed sleeve, whereas the master's gown has a long closed sleeve, square at the end with an arc of a circle above the bottom. The sleeve extends well below the knee, the arm coming through a slit near the elbow. The doctor's gown is characterized by a voluminous bell-shaped sleeve on which appear three velvet bars and by velvet facings or panels of the same color down the front. The navy blue gown trimmed with scarlet velvet, worn by some members of the faculty, indicates fellowship in the American College of Surgeons.

The hood is the most important and distinctive feature of the Code. The hoods for all degrees are lined with silk in the official academic color or colors of the institution conferring the degree and have an edging or trim of velvet, the color of which indicates the course or faculty to which the degree pertains. The lining is exposed when the hood is worn. The bachelor's hood is rather short with a narrow velvet edging. It is not worn by candidates for the baccalaureate but only by those upon whom this degree has been previously conferred. The master's hood is considerably longer, has a wider velvet edging, and exposes more of the lining. The doctor's hood is easily recognized since, of the three types of hoods, it has the widest velvet edging, greatest length, and fullest exposure of the lining, and has wide panels at the side.

The black mortarboard cap with tassel is worn with each type of gown. Those holding a doctor's degree are privileged to wear a gold tassel. Masters and bachelors wear black gowns and tassels that are either black or of the color appropriate to the degree in which they are being graduated. Marshals wear cardinal tassels. The members of the Board of Regents wear doctor's gowns.

Candidates receiving degrees with **distinction**, **high distinction** and **highest distinction** wear medallions with red ribbons, white ribbons and red and white ribbons respectively. Candidates receiving medallions have demonstrated, during the course of their study, superior academic aptitude.

Candidates receiving degrees with **Academic Excellence** are advanced placement students in the Colleges of Nursing and Dentistry who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement.
