Testing Environment

- I understand that the program or testing area cannot control outside stimuli that are out of their control, such as lawnmowers, sirens, or weather-related conditions.
- I understand that I can provide myself with foam earplugs to reduce external stimuli.
- I understand that if there are any concerns with implementing my accommodations in the testing setting, I am responsible for alerting the test proctor and ASC right away.

Meet with Program Faculty/Staff

- Ensure that each of your faculty members has received your accommodation plan that you have sent to them.
- Discuss your testing accommodations with each of your faculty members in advance of the first exam/quiz in which you plan to use your testing accommodations to explain implementation.
 - For example: Confirming where you will be taking the exam and who is the assigned proctor.
- Review each course syllabus for exam dates, times, and other relative testing format details.
- If you or your program faculty have any questions about the approved testing accommodations, please contact the ASC immediately.

Understand Implementation of Testing Accommodation In Each Exam Mode – ExamSoft

- I understand that extended time in ExamSoft is added at the student profile level—meaning that it is applied to all course assessments.
- I understand that upon approval, I will wait until I have received confirmation by your program's college testing administrator that my extended time has been successfully added to my ExamSoft profile.
 - Once I have received this confirmation, I can begin to download exams.
- To waive extended time in one particular course, I understand that I will test in the classroom with my peers. In doing so, I understand that I am opting out of access to extended time for that course and will need to adjust my exam end time accordingly to the proctor's instructions.
