Regulations for Altrusa Scholarships

Altrusa International of Council Bluffs, IA, is an organization of professional women with a commitment to community involvement through diverse activities, one of which is granting scholarships to mature women and men who are in need of assistance, who are highly motivated, and who desire training and skills to better their lives and become employable.

Requirements:

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of, or applying for a scholarship at a college within, the Council Bluffs-Omaha metro area.
- 2. Scholarship requirement is a cumulative G.P.A. of B or higher.
- 3. Applicant must be a second-year student in a two-year program, or a thirdor fourth-year student in a four-year undergraduate program, or a graduate student.
- 4. A person may reapply after receiving the first grant.
- 5. Financial need will be the prime factor for this grant.
- 6. Applicant must fill out one of the Altrusa applications and follow the instructions.

This grant may be made in any amount up to \$2,000.00. If the applicant is approved, the applicant is invited to attend our monthly Altrusa Club meeting, held on the second Tuesday of each month, and to meet club members and receive the check or certificate of payment which is **written to the college the applicant will attend.**

Applications may be delivered by mail or email and must be received by the Altrusa scholarship committee by April 30, with a decision to be made on or before May 31.
