



Navy Health Services Collegiate Program (HSCP)

If you're looking for an exciting career in the medical field, the Navy's Medical Corps (MC) may be the place for you. The Navy's Health Services Collegiate Program (HSCP) can help those students pursuing their medical degree while helping to decrease their financial burden – thus allowing them to focus on their academic career. <u>This is not ROTC</u>, you do not have to wear a uniform to class. This is NOT a scholarship – you can apply for the program even if you are already on a non-military scholarship!

Benefits:

- Monthly salary and tax-free allowances of <u>over</u> \$3,000 during school (actual benefit varies depending on marital status and school location salary ranges from approximately \$40,000 = \$55,000/year)
- Full medical and dental benefits for you.
- Full medical benefits and a cost-share dental plan for your immediate family.
- You will receive a higher salary than your counterparts who received a HPSP scholarship!
- Economical shopping at military grocery stores and department stores.
- Thirty days of <u>paid</u> vacation each year.
- Free worldwide travel on military aircraft on a space available basis.

Requirements:

- Be enrolled in, or accepted to an accredited medical school.
- Be in good standing with your medical school.
- U.S. citizen of good moral character.
- Be in good physical condition.

Upon graduation, you will receive an appointment as an Officer in the Medical Corps.
