UNMC Scholarship FAQs

1. How do I apply for scholarships?

The UNMC Scholarship Application is available on your MyRecords To Do List.

2. What is the deadline to apply for scholarships?

The scholarship application is due by May 1 each year. For students admitted after May 1, scholarship applications must be submitted within 30 days of acceptance.

3. Do I need to complete the scholarship application annually?

Yes

4. Who makes scholarship decisions?

Each of the UNMC Colleges makes their own scholarship decisions.

5. When will scholarship decisions be made?

Scholarship decisions are typically made by July 1.

6. Why did I receive/not receive a scholarship?

Each UNMC college has their own scholarship committee which selects their program scholarship recipients. Please contact your college at the links at the top of this page to inquire about their scholarship selection policies and procedures.

7. How will I find out about my scholarship award?

The College will send a scholarship notification, and the Office of Financial Aid will send an email when the funds have been added to your financial aid package.

8. I am a nonresident student; does UNMC offer scholarships to nonresident students?

UNMC programs provide a limited pool of funds annually for the purpose of awarding nonresident scholarships. The academic programs determine the

amount of the scholarship, the renewal criteria, and the recipients. These scholarships are generally awarded during the annual scholarship awarding cycle. Academic and need based scholarships are awarded based on donor specific criteria. If an academic/need based scholarship is not restricted to Nebraska residents, the academic program may award an academic or need based scholarship to a qualified nonresident student.

9. Will scholarships affect my aid offer?

Aid offers often must be revised upon receipt of scholarship funds. Check MyRecords for the updated information after receipt of the email notification.

10. How and when will I receive my scholarship funds?

Due to federal regulations, the earliest financial aid and scholarship funds can be posted to a student's account is 1 week prior to the start of class.

11. Is my scholarship award renewable?

Most UNMC scholarships are not automatically renewed. Please contact your College for further information.

12.I have Regents Scholarship at another University of Nebraska institution. Can I receive it at UNMC?

UNMC honors Regent Transfer awards for the first year of undergraduate degree programs based upon approval from prior institution. The awarding institution determines the number of hours covered based on their current tuition rate. 13. Can my Buffett Scholarship be transferred to UNMC?

Yes, Buffett Scholarships can be transferred to UNMC for undergraduate programs. Recipients must complete a change of campus form through the Buffett Foundation for approval.

14. Will my Nebraska Career Scholarship be honored at UNMC?

UNMC makes a good faith effort to honor current Nebraska Career Scholarship awards. Since UNMC is a transfer institution, the maximum Nebraska Career
