Dr. Johnson is an informatics specialist with extensive experience in developing and evaluating innovative technologies that support dental education and patient care. Dr. Johnson has focused her recent work in four areas: (1) creation and evaluation of secure cloud-based electronic health systems, (2) the assessment of clinical problem-solving skills, (3) innovative uses of technology for the instruction and evaluation of oral health care providers, and (4) the evaluation of the merit and worth of instructional products and methodologies. Her research in learning technologies has received continuous support from NIH and NSF grants for over 15 years including being the principal investigator on two NIH grants. Dr. Johnson has over 60 peer-reviewed publications. Dr. Johnson has completed multiple leadership programs including being a 2015 graduate of the Hedwig van Ameringen *Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine® (ELAM)*.
